Our *Safety and Environmental Manual* describes the routines and instructions required to ensure safety and environment. The content of the *Safety and environmental manual* has been reviewed and approved in accordance with the requirements in SOLAS chapter IX (The International Safety Management Code, ISM) and EMS ISO 14001.

Our goal is to:

- 1. Create and maintain routines for a safe and environmentally friendly shipping, in accordance with international, national and local rules and regulations.
- 2. Develop and introduce safeguards against all known risks.
- 3. Continuously improve the knowledge and training of the management team and the onboard crew members.
- 4. Continuously improve the safety and environmental protection and to prevent accidents and pollution.
- 5. Continuously follow up long-term and short-term environmental goals.
- 6. Our long-term environmental goal is to reduce air pollution.

Our goal is achieved by:

- 1. Maintain a high level of awareness concerning safety and environment, personal discipline and personal responsibility by following a documented safety and environmental system.
- 2. Actively encourage employees to participate in our efforts to improve safety and protect the environment.
- 3. Keeping our employees informed about all known or potential dangers and risks.
- 4. Through a system of internal controls ensure that company procedures and instructions are followed.
- 5. Continuous follow up rules and regulations relevant to company ships and traffic.

In emergencies the priority is to save lives, protect the environment and prevent damage to ships and other property, in this order.

If needed, do not hesitate to take costs or delays to reduce the risk of accidents, collisions, groundings, pollutions of the environment or anything else that can cause loss of life or damage to the environment, ship or other property.

Nothing in the *Safety and environmental manual* takes away the overall responsibility from the master onboard. The master is required and has the authority to take measures and issue orders necessary to protect life, environment, ships and other property.

Know your ship, know your job, think safe, be safe!
